



Process for Home School Applicants

Homeschooled students attending a recognized accredited Home School as listed on the reverse of this form should complete the GAMES Application for Admission and provide required documentation as listed on the application.

Homeschooled students not attending a recognized accredited Home School should preferably enroll in their home system's high school. While the student will never physically attend this school, (s)he will receive a high school diploma from that school. The high school will evaluate the home school curriculum and produce a transcript. This transcript must be provided to GAMES along with the Application for Admission.

Homeschooled students may also apply by providing the following information in addition to the GAMES Application for Admission:

- ✓ Copy of Declaration of Intent to Home School as filed with the local Board of Education, and
- ✓ The attached Certification Form, and

- ✓ One of the following:
 - ❑ a portfolio with course work from each core class in which the student has enrolled
 - ❑ SAT/ACT (English/math) scores in the top five percentile nationally. The SAT is offered at GAMES on July 29 and August 5. Scores for 07-08 were a 1370 SAT and 31 ACT. Scores for 08-09 will be available later this summer
 - ❑ SAT Subject Test scores listed below. Scores may be used in lieu of portfolio only for the individual class in which the test was taken.
