PROCEDURES & RULES

1. Complete the Middle Georgia College Consolidated Scholarship Application and return to the MGC Scholarship Committee no later than **April 1**. Recipients **must** maintain 12 hrs per semester.
2. Mailed applications must be postmarked no later than **April 1**.
3. All applications will be reviewed by the MGC Scholarship Committee by April 20.
4. The selection of all scholarship recipients will take place in May. The decisions of the Scholarship Committee are final.
5. Scholarships may be adjusted due to over awards. This includes HOPE and private scholarships.
6. Scholarships are awarded for the academic year. The academic year is designated Fall and Spring. **MGC Scholarships will not be used for Summer Semesters.**
7. MGC Scholarships will be used in academic year of awarding. MGC scholarships cannot and will not be deferred.
8. Students will be notified of awarding of scholarship by mail.
9. It is the responsibility of the student to fulfill all requirements to retain any scholarships awarded.
10. Student violating rules of scholarship or being placed on academic or disciplinary probation will forfeit their scholarship the following semester. All scholarships may be revoked if the student violates the College's student code of conduct.
11. The monetary amount of the scholarship will be credited to the student's account at Middle Georgia College. Scholarship credits may be evenly divided between Fall and Spring semesters.
12. Students not attending MGC will not receive MGC scholarships.
13. Scholarship recipients will be asked to attend ceremonies promoting Scholarship awarding.
14. There are no automatic renewals of MGC Academic/Leadership or Alumni Association Scholarships.
15. Recipients of the Scholarship of Opportunity **must** maintain at least 12hrs per semester to be considered for renewal.
16. The Scholarship of Opportunity is automatically renewed for the second semester if the student earns at least a 2.0 GPA at MGC after the first semester and maintains at least 12 hrs per semester
17. Students that wish to extend their Scholarship of Opportunity beyond two semesters must apply for the "Renewal of Scholarship of Opportunity" by April 1. Forms may be obtained from the College Website or the Financial Aid Office.
